RESPONSIBILITIES

- Responsible for the overall quality and production of folded and glued cartons, in addition to preventative care and maintenance of assigned equipment.
- Confirm production schedule.
- Establish make-ready on machine, based on carton style and job requirements.
- Wash and fill glue pots.
- Check case label for correct information prior to startup after make-ready.
- Manage documentation pertaining to the set-up, operation, quality control, and perform basic maintenance.
- Maintain a clean and safe work environment at all times. This includes compliance with plant safety and personal protective equipment requirements.
- May be required to perform other duties as directed.



QUALIFICATIONS

Required skills and experience:

- Experience as a feeder, packer or gluer operator.
- Knowledge of auto-bottom, four-corner, six-corner, and side-seam cartons.
- Ability to read basic measurement tools such as calipers, micrometers, and tape measures.
